Rehearsals will take place close to the theatre.

AUDITIONS ARE OPEN TO ALL. The RSS actively encourages diversity in casting and casting decisions will *not* be constrained by the perceived gender or ethnicity of the roles being auditioned, unless specified by the author.

As this is a physical theatre production, the auditions will be in two parts: Monday 3^{rd} March audition pieces (text) and then, on Tuesday 4^{th} March, callbacks and physical theatre (no experience necessary).

About the play:

Joseph K has a comfortable job in finance and barely notices the growing chaos all around him on the walk to work - the homeless, food banks, protests and the rise in the cost of living. Until, one day, K is arrested. No one will explain what the charges are, but they must be answered. Emily White's adaptation of *The Trial* weaves the nightmare of arrest and injustice into a funny and physical take on Kafka's classic.

Looking for a strong ensemble of 10 actors who are keen to explore physical theatre, multiple roles and expressionist theatre.

Please note that the director will record the auditions for her own personal reference for casting. The recordings will not be shared with anyone and will be deleted after casting.

Characters

Joseph K - split into 4 roles: K1, K2, K3, and K4

- **K1** A cis white male from a privileged background. Arrogant junior analyst at a global investment bank.
- **K2** A trans woman or non-binary person of any descent.
- **K3** A cis female of any descent.
- **K4** A cis male from the global majority.

Ms Grubach - Joseph K's landlady.

Elsa - A burlesque dancer and nurse.

Karla - Joseph K's aunt.

Leni - Male assistant/carer to Huld. Strange. Sexual predator towards Huld's clients.

Huld - Lawyer to Joseph K. Grotesque. Walrus like. Breathing problems.

Titorelli - A social media manager.

Block - Female client of Huld. Older woman.

Prison Chaplain - Chaplain of the cathedral.

Cleaner - A cleaner at the courthouse.

Magistrate - Examining magistrate at the courthouse.

Student - The magistrate's apprentice.

Guards, Inspector, Bank Manager, Colleagues, Whipper, Fruit Seller, Sex Worker, Preachers, Clerk, Water Seller, Petitioners, Volunteer, Glitterman and other small roles to be played by the ensemble.

Audition Pieces

There is only one text edition printed by Faber.

Please prepare two audition pieces, from your preferred category, to demonstrate contrast in character.

Women: please prepare 2 pieces from:

- (1) Ms Grubach: pages 31-32, scene 3, "Come in Joseph K1 Will she take my hand I wonder?"
- (2) K3: pages 68-71, scene 13, Huld "I've been waiting Block when the Advocate is speaking!"
- (3) Block: pages 70-71, scene 13, Huld "Is that Block? Block when the Advocate is speaking!"

Trans woman / Non binary: please prepare (1) below and one other piece from either the Women's or Men's list:

- (1) K2: pages 48-50, scene 8, Leni "Impressive isn't it? K2 Neither do I really"
- (2) Pick one other piece from either the Women's or Men's list.

Men: please prepare 2 pieces from:

- (1) K1: pages 31-32, scene 3, "Come in Joseph K1 Will she take my hand I wonder?"
- (2) Leni: pages 48-50, scene 8, Leni "Impressive isn't it? K2 Neither do I really"
- (3) Huld: pages 68-71, scene 13, Huld "I've been waiting Block when the Advocate is speaking!"

You do not have to be an RSS member to audition but, if cast, you will be required to become a member before the first rehearsal.
